CAMP SET UP GUWAHATI ON 14.12.2016 FOR OPENING OF BANK ACCOUNTS FOR KARIGARS AND ARTISANS AND MOTIVATING THEM IN MAKING CASHLESS TRANSACTIONS

In its efforts to combat the impact of demonetization on handicrafts sector and to facilitate timely payment to the karigars and artisans who are backbone of the Handicrafts sector, Export Promotion Council for Handicrafts has taken initiative for opening of bank accounts and Jan Dhan Accounts in various craft cluster of handicrafts sector.

In the series, camp for opening of bank accounts of karigars and artisans camps was organised at **Guwahati on 14th December, 2016** in office of EPCH





Total six such camps have already been organised by EPCH two at Moradabad & Andhra Pradesh and one each at Agra and Bangalore. Nationalized Oriental Bank of Commerce sent a team of their officials at these craft clusters for the purpose. Apart from opening of bank accounts, they also motivated artisans and karigars to make cashless transaction, Online payments, mobile banking [services like paytm, buddy, e-wallet etc.].

One of the cashless transaction companies namely Paytm have also joined the movement and set up an information kiosk during some of the camps to motivate the karigars and artisans about the benefits of making cashless transactions.
