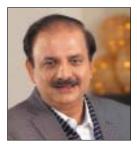

In fact, international hotel chains are increasing their presence in the country, as they will account for around 47 per cent share in the Tourism & Hospitality sector of India by 2020 & 50 per cent by 2022. For infrastructure to cope up with the increasing demand, more than half of the Ministry of Tourism's Plan budget is channelised for funding the development of destinations, circuits, mega projects as well as rural tourism infrastructure projects.

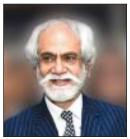

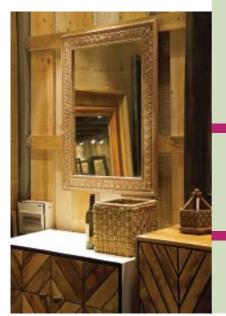

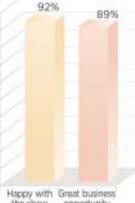
